### **For Adults**

#### **Introduction to Gulf Coast Kids House** (Approx. 20-30 minutes)

Presentation for adults and children providing the past, present and future story of GCKH. Participants will be introduced to the how, when, who, what and where of keeping children safe in Escambia County.

#### **Child Abuse: Recognize, React Responsibly, & Report** (Approx. 60 minutes)

This power point presentation empowers participants to develop their own child abuse prevention plan and to know the steps necessary to end child abuse in our community.

#### **Darkness to Light: Stewards of Children®** (Approx. 2 hours)

This class teaches adults to recognize the signs of child abuse and how to handle a disclosure of abuse from a child. GCKH, also, offers this evidence-informed class monthly in our conference room free of charge.

#### **Darkness to Light Additional Evidence-Informed Training** (Each Approx. 60 minutes)

**Bystander Intervention:** This training will teach participants how to be an active bystander in child abuse prevention and response. Participants will learn about boundary violations and inappropriate behaviors and how to make spontaneous and planned interventions that reinforce boundaries and protect children.

**Healthy Touch for Children:** This training teaches participants some guidelines for healthy touch and safe, respectful ways to interact with children.

**Talking with Children:** This training will teach participants how to talk with children about personal safety and sex so that they have the knowledge that makes children and teens feel much less vulnerable.

**Child Abuse and Mandated Reporting:** This training will teach the definitions and indicators of sexual abuse, physical abuse, emotional abuse, and neglect as well as the legal obligations as a mandated reporter defined by Florida. Highly recommended for educators.

**Commercial Exploitation of Children:** This training teaches participants about the root cause of commercial sexual exploitation and why preventing sexual abuse is important to reducing the risk of children being sexually exploited.

**Create a Cyber Safe Home** (Approx. 60 minutes)

This facilitator led presentation is for parents and adults interested in developing a safer home digital environment for their children and their family.

**Teachers Creating Cyber Safe Kids** (Approx. 60 minutes)

This facilitator led presentation is for teachers interested in assisting children in developing and implementing safe practices in a digital environment.

**Designing A Code of Conduct and Child Safe Environment for Youth Serving Organizations** (Approx. 60 minutes)

This facilitator led presentation is for staff of youth serving organizations interested in developing and implementing a code of conduct and safe practices for youth being served in their organization's environment.

**For Children**

**MBF Child Safety Matters™** (Approx. Two 60 minute sessions per grade level)

Presentation for children K-5<sup>th</sup> grade. This age appropriate, facilitator led, research-based power point class teaches children 5 safety rules and how they relate to all types of child abuse, bullying, cyberbullying and digital abuse.

**MBF Teen Safety Matters™** (Approx. Three 60 minute sessions per grade level)

Presentation for teens 6<sup>th</sup> -8<sup>th</sup> grade. This age appropriate facilitator led, research-based power point class educates and empowers students with information strategies to prevent, recognize, and respond appropriately to bullying, cyberbullying, all types of child abuse and exploitation, digital dangers and relationship violence.

**Safety Net Kids (No Easy Target)** (Approx. 45 minutes)

Children ages 3 and 4 accompanied by a parent. This facilitator led safety program shows children responses to unsafe situations without instilling fear. It teaches kids when it's okay to say "No" to an adult, how to speak up to a safe adult, how to set personal boundaries, and other child abuse safety points as passwords, home safety, and safe and unsafe behaviors.

**Date Safe, Date Smart** (Approx. 60 minutes)

This facilitator led power point presentation is appropriate for students in their teens. Date Safe, Date Smart educates and empowers participants to build healthy youth relationships and help them to end abusive ones safely.
